The Woods Hole Film Festival kicks off tomorrow, and among the entries is "Before We Get to Seattle," a 10-minute short codirected by April Mosqus, who grew up in Lawrence, and Adam Linn, who's from Dorchester. 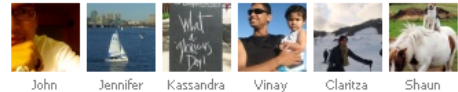
